Welcome to the latest edition of your newsletter from your local policing team.

You said:

Large groups of young people are gathering on Church Road playing field, by the millennium eye. They have been hanging around until the early hours of the morning causing general rowdy and inconsiderate behaviour.

We did:

Local officers have been continuing their high visibility foot patrols around the affected areas. CCTV cameras have been installed to assist in identifying offenders and some groups have been spoken to and warned regarding their behaviour. The Anti-social behaviour Officer has sent letters home to parents and Youth Workers are out and about and engaging with groups of youngsters during the evenings.

You said:

Vehicles are parking inconsiderately on St Johns Road near to the junction with Tunstall Road. Vehicles are parking on both sides of the road, effectively making it impossible for two vehicles to pass each other.

We did:

Local officers work closely with the Parking Enforcement Officers and Staffordshire Highways and have informed them of the problems at the location. The schools have been made aware and any vehicles seen causing an obstruction in future will be issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice.

You said:

There is regular damage being caused to the poly tunnels on the allotments on Church Road playing field.

We did:

Regular foot patrols are being carried out and we are working closely with Staffordshire Moorlands District Council. Offenders are being warned accordingly and the Anti-social behaviour Officer at Staffordshire Moorlands District Council is writing to parents of those involved.

Bogus caller warning

Staffordshire Police is warning local residents to be on their guard against bogus callers following recent incidents in the area.

There are a number of things you can do to protect yourself and your home:

- check the identity of anyone calling at your door
- phone the company they are claiming to be calling on behalf of, using the number in the telephone book, not one the caller provides you with
- don't keep large amounts of cash at home, it really is much safer in the bank
- keep doors locked – even when you are at home
- if you have a door chain, use this every time you answer the door.
